Bayou Wolf is the 5th book in Heather Long's Wolves of Willow Bend series. Bayou Wolf is a great story about a female alpha. The author amazes and stuns with her ability to pull off such a strong female character – I am talking ALPHA strong – and have her remain such a feminine presence. Her insight and strength created a fresh feel pushing an Alpha story up to a new level.

Bayou Wolf in its entirety is a very unique story. All of the Alphas from North America have come to Willow Bend creating a tense situation. The fate of many lies in their hands and how they interact provided a clear glimpse into each of the Alphas. I loved this dynamic that was intertwined with the story of Serafina (Alpha of Delta Crescent) and Linc (Willow Bend pack).

The honesty between Serafina and Linc was part of the allure of this story. I enjoyed their interactions and attractions during every part of the story.

I am not going to lie here. This book contained so many things I already love. Yet, those things were not the basis of what made this a great story. If you have not read this series and love pack dynamics and werewolves, you do not want to miss this series. I cannot wait to see what happens next!

Strangely enough, this book makes me feel conflicted. While the story is written in the same style as the previous ones, I don't think I really connected with either main character - Sera more than Linc. Sera was nice enough and she appears to be a damn good alpha, but I had a hard time believing she truly cared for Linc. Their attraction seemed stilted and rather forced, and I found myself more interested in what other characters were doing than the H and h (especially Brett and Diesel).

Update 11.6.15:

This is hands down one of my favorite series. I reread each book often and found I would initially gloss over or skim this one. I finally realized what I was doing and I have reread this novel in its entirety more than once. Thankfully the original feeling of disconnect hasn't lingered. I have realized that I felt Sera continuously played games and it was hard for me to know when she was being serious. I understand Linc gave his permission to mate, but we weren't privy to any thoughts he had prior to mating Sera, which speaks volumes of the issue with the story. Afterwards I felt they'd be good together, but the mating came right out of left field, leaving me wondering if Sera didn't (knowingly or not) force the issue. This leaves a bit of a black smudge on an otherwise wonderful story.

After having more time to think about it, I am upping my rating from 3 stars to 4, because despite my misgivings about the mating, the remainder of the story and the action contained was beautifully written and in itself stands as a fantastic addition to the series as a whole.
