Burned by a Kiss by Tina Leonard is the 1st book in her new Star Canyon series. After completing this book, which was a little short (200 pages), I am hooked to this series I can't wait to find out what Tina Leonard has in store for us in the future Star Canyon series.

Emma Glass, our heroine, is the town veterinarian, and has lived all her life in Star Canyon. Santana Dark, is our hero, and the oldest brother of the wealthy Dark family, who own their successful ranch in town. Santana has recently returned from deployment, to help his family run the ranch, and is given a dog by his sister, Sierra to keep company. Of course, he has to take the dog, Joe to the vet, running into Emma. It has been years, and Emma has not forgotten her major crush on the gorgeous hunk that Santana is. He too can't take his eyes off Emma. They both find their attraction heating up, but the 5 members of the Dark family will have the wool pulled from under them.

Their father, who died in a suspicious fire, had mortgaged the ranch to a brother no one knew about. The reading of the will has left them with nothing, and a cousin they didn't know, Nick. This is also a surprise to Nick, who also knew nothing about this, as with the death of his father, he is the one inheriting the ranch and all its assets. Nick is a successful investor, and doesn't need the money, but the will is explicit, he must keep it and run it or it will have to be sold.

Between Santana, Sierra and their 3 brothers, they have no where to turn, except to maybe work for Nick or everyone loses the ranch. Santana feels he has nothing to offer Emma, and tries to keep his distance. But their attraction to each other is too strong, and their chemistry is hot. As their romance heats up, Santana begins to work with Nick together to save the ranch. I loved Emma, and Santana together; I adored Sierra and her shenanigans. The start of a new series, the blurb features Emma and Santana as our hero and heroine, but honestly, other characters stole the spotlight. Emma is Star Canyon's new vet, as her father has recently passed away and she

took over his business. She loves her job and the small town she lives in. Santana is recently home from the Middle East and he heads back to his family ranch, where his multiple brothers and sister, Sierra, help out. Their father also recently died, and when they go to read his will they are shocked to discover the entire five million dollar ranch was left to their cousin, Nick. Apparently, Santana's father had big gambling debts, which led to his brother (Nick's dad) helping him out, and then securing the ranch in his will.

So now Santana, his brothers, and his sister Sierra are out of their family legacy. But that is not all - they also found out they are all adopted (they had no idea) and their dad was a CIA agent in the witness protection program.

Santana and Emma went to school together, and Emma always had a crush on him, he even kissed her once in school - but then he enlisted and they lost touch. But now he is back in town and their chemistry is back on the burner.

Santana and Emma's chemistry and sexual tension start off well - it's a cute start. But once Nick gets introduced, and they lose their family ranch, things go downhill quick. Their story starts to almost entirely focus on Sierra and her rebellion against Nick getting the property, and Nick's attraction to Sierra. Since they found out they were adopted, Sierra isn't related to Nick. Pretty much the entire book is Nick and Sierra - and ALL of their problems. Once in a while we get a scene or two with Santana and Emma together. They jump into bed together but I needed much more focus on their romance and how they somehow end up with a HEA at the end. I assume Sierra and Nick get their own book next, so why they took up all the page time in this one confuses me.

The ranch leaving Santana's family and the fact their father was CIA and they were all adopted was very much glossed over. Just felt out of place.

I received an ARC of this title in exchange for an honest review and here it is: 4 stars.

Tina Leonard is a fairly new author for me, and if *Burned by a Kiss* is any indication of her skills, I'll be reading a lot more of her, especially the rest of her Star Canyon series.

This novel drew me in from the very beginning which is where we meet Emma Glass, who has taken over her father's veterinary practice in Star Canyon, NM, and the hero, Santana Dark, a Navy SEAL, who has just returned to the family ranch from his fourth and final deployment in Afghanistan. He's bringing the pup that his sister, Sierra, adopted for its check-up. It's clear from the start that these two are very attracted to one

another, an attraction dating back to a kiss Santana gave Emma on a dare back in high school where Emma was considered the class geek. That kiss is something they both remember fondly.

Santana has retired from the Navy and is back to work the ranch with his sister and his brothers, Luke, Cisco and Romero, after the death of their father, who was a local firefighter, in a suspicious blaze and explosion at the warehouse. The siblings are happy to be reunited until they are notified that they are to meet with an attorney about the conditions of their late father's estate--and the revelation of those conditions leave them all reeling and uncertain about their futures, as a family and as to the ranch they've all called home.

Although this novel is Emma and Santana's story, the other characters, especially their young and volatile sister, Sierra, are intriguing enough to make this reader want to follow this series. It's well-written, sexy, sassy, and above all, heartwarming. This series is definitely off to a good start.
