To be honest the story is getting stale and repetitive, the crisis can't always just be another guy or another girl in their lives to potentially break them up. Megumi seems to be the only interesting character right now.

There are a couple of interesting points worth mentioning in this volume. The first is obviously how realistic it felt to read about this transition between High-School to University and how your life and your friendships change with it. I really liked how Hazuki portrayed the beginning of new friendships and the struggle that is to maintain school friendships, specially when you and your old friends decide to follow separate ways. Hazuki is still keeping the old gang together (which is something that does happen in the beginning), but you can see how they slowly drift apart. The author did leave a note that she is going to "give them a happy ending", but I don't think the happy ending necessarily has to be in the form of them all being together (though I suspect this is exactly what will happen). People tend do drift away and this is fine. Sometimes friends are not meant to be forever, but if those moments in which they were together were worth it, then the friendship has served its purpose.

Another thing worth noting is the "rivalry" between Rin and Megumi. Not so much their relationship, but the way things work in this world: sometimes you'll put a lot of effort in something just to have it snatched by someone who supposedly is luckier than you. I liked how Megumi faced this in a mature way, specially in comparison to her own self in the past volumes.

I'm only a bit sad not to see Kai as often as I did before, he is still one of my favorite characters...
