Geir's story is an unusual one in Dale Mayer's Seals of Steel saga. The plot is not as fast paced as in the other books, as the author takes time to explore the personalities of the key characters. While at the beginning of the saga the stories tended to be more dark and dramatic, reflecting the pain and the suffering that the members of the team were still going through, in Geir the atmosphere lightens up. The Seals of Steel are starting to heal, rediscovering friendship and self-motivation while chasing after the entity that orchestrated the brutal attack that left them barely alive just two years prior. They are now moving on, their injuries healed and barely noticeable, thinking about the future with determination and hope. Geir and Jager, the male protagonists, are good examples of this state of mind. While relentless in completing their hunt, they take the time to explore their feelings and to make plans about the future.

Blossom, the heroine, is an artist, and, apparently a quite different persona from the exceptionally skilled women that have joined the team in the previous books. Over the course of the story, however, she reveals a strong and resilient personality. She also has a caring, sensitive soul and a passionate heart.

In preparation for the grand finale of the saga, this episode ends with plenty of cliffhangers. It is, however, an enjoyable part of the general plot that provides a new, more lighter and hopeful perspective to the story of the Seals of Steel team.

I received a free copy of this book via Booksprout and am voluntarily leaving a review.

Dale Mayer's writes a lot of series about SEALs and the military. However, her "Seals of Steel" series is one of my favorites. The premise of this series is that a team of eight SEALs hit a landmine while on duty overseas. One man dies and the other men are all seriously injured. When the men are finally able to get on with their lives, they discover that their "accident" wasn't really an accident. Someone did this on purpose. They decide that they must find out what happened and why.

In this particular book, Geir continues the investigation into the "accident" that changed all of their lives. Jager, another injured SEAL, joins him in his quest. Both men travel to California to find information about Mouse, the one SEAL who died. They want to investigate the area where he spent his early life, interview friends he grew up with and the people who knew him.

One of their fellow SEALs recommends that Geir and Jager stay at a Bed and Breakfast they often frequented. It is owned and run by Morning Blossom, who eventually becomes Geir's love interest.

Geir and Jager spend most of their time in California investigating Mouse's life, his friends and the environment where he grew up. Unfortunately, their search triggers several disturbances in Morning's B&B which disrupts her business and her life.

When all is said and done, Geir and Jagar learn a lot of information about Mouse and his life. Much of what they learn is shocking, heartbreakingly difficult to believe. In the end, however, this is not enough information to answer all of their questions.

Unfortunately, even though Geir and Jagar leave California with a substantial amount of information, they still do not have enough to find out who caused their “accident” and why.

I was kindly provided this book as an ARC; in exchange for my honest review. This is book 6 in the SEALS Of Steel series.

The “SEALS of Steel” were an eight-man SEAL team unit that was misled/ambushed/given “bogus” orders that caused them to hit a landmine during transport. All the men were grievously injured and one man (“Mouse”) died. The remaining seven SEALs are investigating to find out what happened and why; and hopefully in the end to avenge Mouse’s death.

You certainly must read this series in order or you will be lost. This is definitely a series with layers of stories within a STORY.

This book centers around Geir & Morning (Blossom). The only other team member that is represented in this story is Jager. There is reference to Levi & also Mason. These characters are from two of Ms. Dale’s other related SEALs series. Also quite good.

Geir & Jager are in San Diego trying to investigate Mouse’s background as events to this point have led the team to believe their “accident” & the rash of tragic events the team members closest friends & family have suffered are somehow linked to their deceased team member, Mouse. Morning Blossom owns a large bed & breakfast & is an aspiring artist. The story starts well, gets slow & fairly convoluted (not typical of Ms. Dale’s works); and then picked up again only to really leave the reader hanging at the end. I certainly don’t have the authors incredible talent so I have no idea how it could have been improved, but this story while it filled in a very few blanks to the overall STORY; it didn’t reach the same caliber I’ve come to expect from Ms. Dale.

I did feel as if the story was cut a little short or was maybe rushed. This storyline is involved and probably won’t come to a conclusion or semi-conclusion for at least a few more books.

With the help of Mason (SEALs of HONOR), Geir is booked into a B&B in San Diego, where his presence would be less obvious to the killer he seeks than if he stayed with Levi's group at Legendary Security (SEALs for HIRE) in Coronado. B&B owner Morning Blossom is manager and co-owner of the huge Victorian house and dreams of a career as an artist. Lack of confidence keeps her from her best work, so the B&B pays the bills for now. Geir arrives to check in and finds her in the kitchen baking bread, followed a few minutes later by Jager. It's clear to Morning that these two men are close friends reuniting after a long time, that they are very special and are there on a very important and dangerous mission. Geir and Jager also each find Morning very attractive and try to shield her from involvement in their mission.
