Nick's life is out of balance as he recovers from an accident. One morning when he wakes, he discovers five caterpillars on his window. They crawl in his pocket and throughout the day they change to butterflies that seem to whisper words of encouragement when his family needs them most. Though he is having trouble walking Nick's abilities are discussed with dignity throughout. The story is a great read aloud for families with small children and a good way to introduce some of the key concepts of the Virtues Project, a UN recognized program to encourage peace and mindfulness (dare I say balance and symmetry) in life.

The last butterfly has a final word for Nick. As he works to walk and run again, despite being slightly off balance, he wobbles forward with a little Determination.
