Aww! Such a fast and fun novella! I really enjoyed reading about Char and Blayze. This story is short, sweet and to the point. It works great as a stand alone story but is better enjoyed if you read the previous book "Scorched by Darkness." (It gives a bit of history as to what happened to Blayze and sets up this novella.)

Char is a half-breed dragon with the ability to shift into a dragon which is very rare for half-breeds. He's been assigned to protect Blayze, Synge's daughter, who was just found. She was cursed when she was born and is now in a magical coma. The last thing Char expected was to be magically pulled into the past with a fully awake Blayze! And she's trying to stop the person who put the curse on her in the first place!

POSSIBLE SPOILERS:

This story was a solid 5 star until the very abrupt and unsatisfying ending. It wasn't a cliffhanger; it did end on an HEA, but it jumped from point V to point Z, with nothing in between.

Characterization of Levett was excellent, as always; he was a standout. The characterizations of the hero and heroine were acceptable for novella length. Characterizations of secondary recurring characters were definitely on the light side, but the novella length restricts full development. The characterizations of the villains were also circumscribed by the novella length.

The plot had great potential, but it ultimately disappointed. A lot of the initial action took place off-stage, but it was still quite entertaining. Then we got near the end of the story and it just wrapped up. One minute the hero and heroine were in the process of escaping, the vampires still had the dragon, Styx, in stasis on the club's roof, the dragon, Bolt, who had disappeared in the past and was presumed dead, appeared in the present and the villain dragon was in the past and undiscovered by Styx. Next minute, the hero and heroine are in the present and mated but there is no scene of a meeting with her parents, no scene of the vampires releasing Styx, no scene of the big reveal to Styx and no scene of how the villain is confronted and punished by Styx. Just, there they are, back in the present so isn't that wonderful.

These dragon stories are wasted as novellas. They have so much potential as longer novels. As it is, they feel shallow and incomplete. Had it not been for Levett, I would have been tempted to give this book one or two stars.

I recommend this book for fans who are completists, but those new to Alexandra Ivy should try one of her 'Guardians of Eternity' books.
