Letting Go was the very first book we read by Jenn Foor and we were hooked on these characters the rain scene still one of Kristy's faves as well as her writing (#J4addict). Just like Letting Go, the first book in the series, Joshua had me in knots with the angst and the depth of emotion gripped my heart and squeezed tight until tears formed.

"Love is relentless. It comes in fast, but cripples you when it ends. It's beautiful and understanding. Love isn't forced. You can't make it happen. It's not planned. It's not just a set of words. It's a feeling overwhelmed by that person. It's not desperate. It's patient. It's a slow fire that keeps burning. It doesn't stop when we want it to. It's not a switch."

Josh is the youngest Healy's, he cruises through life with no direction. He has a love for video games, drinking and women, there is never a shortage of women he doesn't care for labels or commitment. Laying eyes on a gorgeous blonde at a car dealership, he wants to take her for a drive...

Tamsyn is working at the family car dealership when Josh starts putting the moves on her. Tamsyn has just had her heartbroken by the man she thought was going to be her forever. Being in the right place at the right time works out well for Josh, Tamsyn needs to get away from her ex, after learning of the deceit and lies he has told her. Not only has he cheated on her with her roommate, he is also going to have a baby with her.

It's unusual waters for Josh being friends with a girl but they have a lot in common, he's usually with a girl one two three times and see you later but when he's not with Tamsyn he kind of misses her and looks forward to the next time they are together. Being in a relationship is new to Josh, he loved a girl once, his best friend Wes's sister Liv, even though she treated him badly and broke his heart he still carries feelings for her.
