Schlafly and Neumayr explain the rise to power and the ideological differences between the Far-Left Progressives, Barack Hussein Obama and those who support, pave, and administer that power; and the Judao-Christian ideology that defines the United States of America from its inception. No Higher Power reviews the history of the man, President Obama, and the personnel in the machine that has been operating for decades culminating in the last two presidential victories. I read this book after Obama left office, which means that many of the points the author made, based on the 2012 writing, were no longer relevant, now that President Trump has rolled back much of the Obama agenda.
