SPELLBOUND by Michelle M. Pillow is the second installment in the author's delightful Warlocks MacGregor series. The first book, LOVE POTIONS (<http://www.readingbetweenthewinesbook...>), was one of my favorite reads in 2014, so it was absolutely imperative that I read SPELLBOUND! I was not disappointed! The whole series is a laugh a minute. It's overflowing with magic, mayhem and sexy guys in kilts (and some without) - need I say more?

Even though this is the second book in the series, it can be enjoyed as a standalone if that is your preference. There are interconnected characters and there were events in the first book that affected this tale, but the author fills in what you need to know as the story progresses. That said, the first book was even better, in my opinion, than this one - and that's saying something as they're both very good. I highly recommend the whole series.

The series takes place in the small town of Green Vallis in Wisconsin and features the MacGregor family of Scottish warlocks and witches. The clan includes parents, siblings, aunts, uncles, and cousins. In the first book, the family purchased a mansion that had been vacant for years so they could all be together in a relatively safe place and be close to nature. They need the trees and plants on the property to replenish their magic (and to run through the woods naked.)

This is the story of Iain MacGregor, a hunky Scottish druid like his brother, Eric, from the first book, and Jane, a magically-gifted woman with a sad history. Jane runs the local nursery in Green Vallis. She loves plants and they love her. She moved here to escape from her nightmarish family and live out her final days as she believes her time is nigh. She sees ghosts and hallucinates. She needs funds and hopes the MacGregors will hire her to care for their gardens so she can pay her bills. She doesn't want to get involved with anyone as she doesn't have long to live. Her attraction to Iain scares her witless.

Iain can't seem to keep his magic under control now. It keeps escaping and creating situations. He's known as a Romeo and normally has women running after him. But when his eyes alight on Jane, she ran from him! That has never happened and his family sure won't let him forget it! The only way he can find to enjoy her company is to hire her to work the landscape on their estate. But, when his mother sees Jane, she screams at her and chases Jane away. Iain just can't win...

I loved both the hero and the heroine, but have to say that Jane's family was creepy from her mother to her brother to her dead step-mother. Yuck! I can see why Jane wanted to get away from them all!

Fans of the first book will be thrilled with the beginning of this one as readers get to witness Erik, our hero from LOVE POTIONS, proposing to Lydia, the heroine from the same book. I loved those two and I almost cried in happiness at the outset. Thank you, Michelle, for allowing your fans the enjoyment of that happy, heartwarming moment. Of course, it's not a run of the mill marriage request. You'll have to pick up this book to find out how Erik proposes. :-)

SPELLBOUND was a charming return to Green Vallis with the MacGregor clan! Don't worry about a cliffhanger as there isn't one. The happy-ever-after ending was a hoot; It was perfect and I couldn't stop laughing. The whole series is extremely fun and witty. I love the whole crazy cool family. I especially enjoy the pranks that they play on each other. I would highly recommend this series to anyone who enjoys farcical Scottish paranormal romances!
