The setup for Three More Wishes is a pornastic Fantasy Island with insta love, boners weeping with constant need and HEA's for all around. The formula is fun and if you start the book knowing what you're getting into, you can enjoy it for the happy fuckfest that it is. Don't try and analyze it and make it into something it's not, just wallow in the need like a happy little slut, clock out from reality for a bit, and relax on the sultry shores of Island Pound Town.

Full disclosure, I have not read the first book with the first three wishes and the backstory of the triad that are the island's hosts, but there was enough info to get the gist without leaving me in the dark. The book starts with Guard and Damian working on getting back into James's heart and his pants. These three are the triad that run the island and they each have a role in making sure their client's fantasies get fulfilled. The three don't show up again until the end so you can consider them the prologue and epilogue. What little I got from these horny bastards I liked so I would definitely like to read more of them on their own.

Like I said, there's a formula here and each wish follows it pretty faithfully with enough variance to keep things interesting. A man has a fantasy, he throws all his dollars at the island and the island finds him his perfect prescription for magical peen. They have five days to bone their way to happiness, and none of them waste any time. I've got to give them all props, for that and since I'm sure these trips are not cheap my frugal inner self appreciated them not wasting time on ridiculous niceties when the clock was ticking.

I'm positive there is something in the water there because the magical peen never fails to lead to not only perpetual boners, but true love and HEA's.

The first story with Cameron as the main MC was the longest and probably my favorite. It's completely implausible but whatever, he was just so sad and needy and when he was fit with his magical peen (much like Cinderella and her slipper – with the slipper being the peen. Obviously) and then all his dreams came true and I was happy for him. It's sweet enough to give a reader cavities, but when two guys are matched up that well, you can't help but let your heart grow three sizes and love the love by way of the dick.

The second two stories had a focus on BDSM as a fantasy element, but it's more BDSM-lite and I did like how the author used their fantasies to get to the root of what the characters really needed which wasn't necessarily what they wanted. Three More Wishes is the book two in the Rainbow Island series, incredibly I missed the first one but apart for some more details about the relationship between the three hosts of the island, James, Guard and Damien (which I would love to know), this re-release worked well as a standalone to me. If you already have read this author, you'll know what to expect. Sean Michael is great at writing very hot scenes, sexy and dirty just how I like them. And the sex is never pointless, it's just the garnish to lovely and sweet plots.

In Three More Wishes I get to know three new couples and their relative meetings and starting of new relationships.

It was very emotional seeing Cameron first so resigned and then start to believe in Xander and the reality of a future together.

Ben and Tip relationship was more adventurous, Ben is a writer interested in knowing what it means to be kidnapped. Things don't go exactly how Ben expected, on the contrary he will find the unexpected Tip. And I can assure you, since I didn't read the blurb before starting the book, for a moment I truly thought he was kidnapped.

The last couple was probably my favorite. Leo and David story was hot and cute. Leo is a dom looking for another dom who will help Leo better understand sub's minds. That dom is David but David is also in love with Leo since forever.

To me, this book is all about chances. Random chances, second chances and even third. It's about giving people what they are afraid to want, giving them the safety and security to be able to voice their fears, their concerns and what they are most afraid to hope for.

This starts out with a rather hot interlude between friends, lovers and business partners James, Guard and Damien but as always happens it fizzles out with grief and guilt. I am desperate to see how these three get on and whether they can save what they once had.

The first of our fantasies involves Cameron, a man who has cashed in everything he owns to have one final hurrah but he ends what can only be described as his despair. Cameron is slowly losing his sight and has no intention of sticking around to live a life in the shadows. His partner for the week is Xander, a man who is looking for 'the one'. He needs someone to love and look after and he may have found his dream in Cameron if he can just persuade the man to live again.

The second fantasy is far more risqué. Ben is an author who wants to give up all control – in fact he wants more than that as he wants to be kidnapped and have his control taken away. This is definitely something that worked better in Ben's head than it did in reality. Tip has been chosen to be the aggressor – a gentle man who makes a couple of trips to the Island a year to help the guys out. Although one of these men will need to safeword it remains to be seen what the rest of the week will bring once their emotions are on a more even keel.

The third fantasy was definitely my favourite this time round. There is something about 2 very dominant men coming together that intrigues me and Leo and David were great together. Each book is three stories of men who come to the island seeking a particular BDSM fantasy. Three men run the island, Guard, Damian and James, however I found myself wondering about the back story of the men as James is pushing away his lovers because he's in a wheel chair, but it's unclear what happened but Damian believes he's responsible.

The three stories are a man going blind whose intention is to commit suicide after this fantasy, however the man chosen to be with him is seeking someone to care for, and he fits the bill. The other is an author of thrillers who wants to try a kidnap/slave fantasy. However it doesn't go as well as he expects. The third is a Dom who wants to be a sub for 5 days to better understand what it's like and is shocked when he sees he knows the guy chosen to be his Dom for the week.
