For Teo, married at fifteen to the brutal Russian conqueror of her beloved Siberia, it is love at first sight when she meets General Duras. Andre is put off guard by Teo's openness and outright seduction of him. However, Andre becomes enamored of Teo's charms despite himself. Their love threatens disaster for the French army and promises to change the course of the war and history.

Realistically how can two people meet, have sex and fall madly in love in two days in 1799? She in one paragraph states her faithfulness to her husband and in the next is having sex with Andre and asking him to give her a child! The back of the book says she was "forced to marry the brutal Russian General who enslaved her people", but you never know more about her life before Khorsakov entered it. What was her life like before her people were conquered? What made Khorsakov so cruel? He was nothing more than a stock character-one with the word "villain" printed on his forehead.

"**Taboo**" is a somewhat disturbing book to read. Johnson seems to have been of two minds when she wrote this story. One part of the story is pure history, filled with facts and statistics, which makes it difficult for those who do not love historic fact to read. It seems like Johnson was so absorbed with the war details in this book that she forgot to develop her characters.
