While the overall writing wasn't extraordinary and the plot relatively short and simplistically sweet, I found this to be a wonderfully pleasant little comfort read. It's nice to see an Alpha/Beta/Omega (Omegaverse) shifter story without insta-mate or forced mating. The buildup started somewhat slowly but then developments moved very quickly, leaving me yearning for a bit of more palpable chemistry between the pair. (In some ways, it ended up feeling like a mating of convenience).

Still, while not knocking my socks off, it's a wonderfully escapist "rescue the abused, weak wolf" who finds comfort in the arms of a sure, steady, and strong Alpha.

The background story was certainly interesting enough for a sequel (and perhaps some real mpreg and not just the potential), and it would be nice to have more relationship chemistry explored (beyond "we kind of like each other" and "our wolves respond a bit to one another, and hey, an Omega in heat needs an Alpha mate").

I'm a sucker for a comforting "rescue the abused Omega" story, so 3.5 stars rounded up to four.

Rating 3.5 This was a nice novella that felt longer than its actual word count (in a good way). I'm someone who loves stories of abused or mistreated omegas finding a strong, kind alpha to give them help and love. Ro, our omega, is a strong character by virtue of what he's been through and I couldn't help myself from just falling in love with him. Sebastian is caring and loving without sacrificing his alpha strength. I also really respected Sebastian as a leader and the way he ran the pack. The way omegas are handled here is interesting and while mpreg is obviously part of this world, there's not a pregnancy in this book. The one real sex scene is not torrid even though it takes place during a heat. It's more loving and sweet than truly erotic. There is a lot happening both within the pack and between packs broaden the story beyond the relationship. I found all these developments interesting and thought they helped the story feel real, in addition to highlighting Sebastian's leadership. Seeds are sewn for further developments and I am wondering whether this series will follow the same pack or shift to omegas in different packs. Either way it was a great series starter!

Though I might of wished for more world building in general this is a strong start to a series. Ro and Sebastian were sort of thoughtful together - which sounds weird and unhot but it's not. This is not a "mate" story with instalust/love. Ro needs to learn to trust again and that trust takes a while to build. Sebastian gets it - completely - and here is a true alpha who gives time and space and knows how to create an environment where Ro can trust him (without forcing it). There is an "evil" pack (or more accurately an evil

alpha) and then things going on outside with other wolves that we don't see - and not as many secondary characters in the main pack as I would expect if this is focused on them. I enjoyed this one alot!

The writing needed more physical and sensory descriptions for the environment and shifters - looks, sensations, smells, sounds, etc. I felt like it was a coloring book and I had to fill in the detail. This defect negatively impacted the single sex scene, making it somewhat dull. But it was a lovely story with very likeable MCs.

I do think at times the writing felt a bit awkward and formal, and there was some unnecessary repetition and overlap between chapters since it switched POV, but I will definitely be looking forward to the next book in the series.
