Lawyer isn't Ky's career goal, but she's prepared to be a teen version of when in order to track down the truth behind her father's imprisonment. She just has to deal with the bullies and the bad memories following her around upon her return to her old high school. They all know about her dad, but they all also know about that night that produced the photos that chased her out of town. It doesn't help that her dad's old partner as put a babysitter on her, a handsome FBI agent with zero trust in her last name. What starts as investigating what happened with her dad turns into investigating the past, knowing she must uncover what happened to her first before she can focus on the next, if she can make it out alive.

I know I'm not the first to say it, but this was just like watching Veronica Mars. Ky is a tough girl with a sassy attitude and the ability to throw a mean punch if she has to. What starts as a single investigation turns into a multi-faceted story about a small town with dark secrets kept quiet by deep pockets. Of course, she's still only in high school, but somehow she knows the ropes. She's got contacts in the FBI, a father that's passed his determination onto her, and two of the best friends around. What happened to her during her freshman year is a story we've all heard, the kind we'd never wish on anyone, and her outcome is just as dire as those we hear on the news. Rich, popular jocks getting away with assault, a girl left embarrassed and with a tarnished reputation, but Ky just uses that as fuel. She fights the system, manages to do her homework, and despite the danger at every turn continues to face fear head on to uncover the truth and protect it from happening to others.

While *Dare You to Lie* is definitely a young adult story, the story is one that is relatable and interesting to read for readers of all ages. If you like suspense, characters with tenacity, and mysteries you can't predict, this one's for you. Where are all my Marshmallows fan at? If you are a fan of that sassy, loveable trouble-maker *Veronica Mars* then you're going to love Ky Danners.

This book is marketed as a cross between *Veronica Mars* and *Riverdale* and that sounds about right. *Dare You to Lie* basically plays out like the first season of *Mars* and I was still withdrawing from the series, so this book was just the hit I needed. Our main protagonist, Ky Danners, is a spunky, sarcastic bundle of trouble and I loved her. The book starts out with Ky's father for a crime she claims he didn't commit and she's moving back to her hometown to try and move just that.

The main storyline in this book is Ky trying to find out who took topless photos and shared them with the entire school when she lived her last. There are six suspects and she is determined to find out who was really responsible. All the characters do get some development and some stay fairly in the background on purpose - I assume for the next book. I loved Ky's friendship with her best friend Garret and I loved the romance that is hinted at in this book with someone I will not name. I don't want to ruin any of the surprises in this one. The romance is barely there in this one though and the actual mystery does take 100% priority. The friendships are great, the villains are frustrating and you'll want to throw them off a balcony and many of the citizens in this town are shady as hell.

Her family left a couple years earlier after Ky had naked pictures taken at a party and leaked online. The suspects were all football players and they were protected instead of her. One was also her ex boyfriend.

Ky falls back into her normal friendship with Garrett easily. She didn't really talk to him when she was gone and it really broke him. But he's a great guy and willing to let it go. They also become friends with the new girl from Canada, Tabby. The friendship between these three really made the story for me. They were all so sarcastic and funny, but the love was obvious. Tabby fit right in with them.

Kylene still wants to prove who took those photos of her and she also wants to find a way to prove that her dad is innocent. She's smart, but she also can't keep quiet and it makes her a target. Some of the football players start threatening her. She gets followed, harassed, and her house is broken into. Still reeling from naked photos from freshman year, Kylene is repeatedly confronted by bullies, though she gives as good as she takes. With the help of some friends, Kylene investigates what really happened the night she was photographed. Things are about to get dangerous.

Kylene, sarcastic and ready for a fight, unlike most YA characters. Her strong sense of justice never waivers; the corruption she encounters only makes her more determined. Unafraid to get physical, she fights the boys responsible for her humiliation. I wasn't comfortable with the guys getting physical with her.

DARE YOU TO LIE is nonstop action and intrigue. Any number of suspects could have been responsible for what happened to Kylene freshman year, changing my theories frequently.
