The description and the author's own note call this a 'romantic thriller'. Well it's not. Its almost like a play being staged and the reader knows almost everything that is happening and that the characters have no clue as to what is happening. But that's not to take anything away from this book.

Things happen over 24 hours technically, but the author sets up a lot of side stories at the start which go well into the past, but they tie up well at the end. The conversations stay easy flowing and funny right till the end. The story never takes itself too seriously. The writing style is very colloquial and it makes for some really quick reading.

About the story, its a bit of an oddball caper, where a couple gets mixed up in some nasty business and get out of it through a lot of muddling and some help from friends. Most of the story and the buildup happens in the minds of the characters and this is another of the book's stronger points. Almost Guy Ritchie territory. But the sad part is that most of it happens amidst the rampant destruction of the Western Ghats. The description of the train through the ghats reminded me of my trek along the abandoned railway track and how much the Ghats destroy the tracks.

If you're looking for a good Kannada book to get started with, I'd recommend this. A really good and fun read.
