His appearances in the 3 previous books in this series left me with a bad impression and I have to say that going into reading this book I wasn't sure I could look past all that and connect with him on any level other than he's hot as hell. Fortunately, Tyler proves to be a lot more complex than what's on the surface and the glimpses we got previously into his character only scratched the surface of his true nature. Once I got to understand him, I felt sorry for him more than anything and wanted so badly for Tyler to come to his senses and open his eyes to the amazing woman right in front of his face. It took a while for Tyler to show his vulnerabilities and open up to Katie in a genuine way but was well worth the wait. I loved them together and admired Katie for getting to know Tyler through friendship and forming a strong foundation built on trust and respect before putting out for the notorious womanizer.

This is another quick and easy read that you will fly through. The other boys whom we've grown to love all make appearances as well.
