Art student Lucy loves sex. She loves sex so much that she’ll gladly partake in it with any guy who is willing to have her – which, as far as she is concerned, is every guy. Lucy’s high-strung, controlling grandmother hates that Lucy loves sex, and forms a cunning plan to have her granddaughter behave in a way that she deems appropriate. If Lucy manages to abstain from sex for 100 days, then her grandmother will fund her dream art exchange trip to Italy. Lucy can’t back down – not if it means living her dream. Besides, it can’t be that hard, right?

Enter sexy bodyguard, Chad. Hired by Lucy’s grandmother to make sure she upholds her end of the bargain, Chad follows Lucy around like a shadow. A ridiculously attractive and incredibly tempting shadow. Will Lucy be able to resist living with a man who both irritates her, and gets her all hot and bothered, all at the same time? Maybe things aren’t as easy as they seem...

I really thought I’d like this book. The premise sounded fun and light-hearted, with some good romantic potential. Unfortunately, I was left feeling incredibly disappointed. About a fifth of the way through, I knew this one wasn’t going to be for me – but I persevered, living in hope that it would redeem itself sometime before it reached its conclusion. It didn’t.

Lucy was, quite possibly, one of the most irritating protagonists I’ve ever had the misfortune of reading – and this is coming from someone who has suffered through Anastasia Steele and Bella Swan. She was so immature and selfish the entire way through. Her inner dialogue was completely exhausting, too. I think she was supposed to come across as funny but, for the most part, she just irritated the living daylights out of me. Some of the things she thought – or said – came across as incredibly childish, especially for someone who was supposed to be of college age. I mean, “I bet it was a chick. Damn her. I hated her.” Come on! Also, if I had to hear about her damn “sex eyes” and how “no man could handle them” one more time... It was almost as bad as Ana and her “inner goddess.” Eurgh.
