

Stories contained in this volume: Moloch, Olesya, Night Duty, The White Poodle, I Was An Actor, The Gambrinus Emerald, The Garnet Bracelet. Aleksandr Ivanovich Kuprin (1870-1938) was Russian novelist and short-story writer. He was an army officer for several years before he resigned to pursue a writing career, and was a friend of Maxim Gorky. He won fame with The Duel (1905), a novel of protest against the Russian military system. In 1909, Yama: The Pit, his novel dealing with prostitution in Odessa, created a sensation. Kuprin left Russia after the revolution but returned in 1937. Some of his best short stories of action and adventure appear in The Garnet Bracelet, originally published in 1917.

Uneven collection of stories. Kuprin also wrote 'Yama: The Pit' about prostitution. He was willing to tackle scandalous topics, but also wrote about the supernatural and his interests, which included flying. His most famous story is 'The Duel', not included in this collection. He was schooled in military institutes, but left the service at age 24 and spent the rest of his life hustling to make a living as a journalist and author. After several years in the southwest, he moved to St Petersburg and moved in literary circles (Bunin, Gorky, Chekhov, etc.) While he supported the Potemkin sailors in 1905, he was less enthusiastic about the Bolshevik revolution and ended up living abroad. However, he turned to alcohol and did no more significant writing.

These tales include some about intense love, both requited (Solomon and Sulamyth) and unrequited (the title story). Others are quite different: a version of the Faust story, a sketch of circus people, an afternoon at the bullfights. The descriptions are lush, but veer over the top at times. I thought the Faustian and bull fight tales the most effective, but none of them made me want to read more Kuprin. No stars doesn't mean it's terrible, just that I am not motivated to rate it.
