Did you ever finish a book and think to yourself "WTF did I just read"? That's what I felt when I finished UnScrew Me by Hailey Faiman.

I love a good MC story. Unfortunately, this was not a good story. This is a story about a really bad guy and the doormat woman he basically orders around and she does whatever he says.

Silver is the Treasurer of the Savage Beasts, a completely "illegal" MC (meaning they only deal in illegal things, like transporting drugs). The story starts 20 years earlier. He's in love with Savanna, who is the bitch (a term we hear at nauseam in this book) of his "brother" and his the "brothers" kid. Hawke, the "brother" takes off, leaving the club to deal with the aftermath of his leaving, which is devastating for Savanna. Silver pines for her for 20 years, raising her kid, and his own and then he meets Presley, who is his son's teacher.

Firstly, Silver is a really crappy dad. So much so that his own child tells Presley that his dad "is a bad guy" and "will hurt you". Why would you want to be with a man whose own child tells you to stay away from? Great sex apparently.

Presley is a total doormat of a character. She has a few moments where she wants to leave Silver, but he doesn't let her. He's decided she's his. Come on. This book sets women's right back with it's portrayal of a woman who can't possibly live without a man - a man she knows virtually nothing about and doesn't know that what he does for a living is illegal.

The most ridiculous part of this story is the branding. To claim Presley as his own, she has to be branded. Literally branded with a branding iron. ARE YOU FRICKING KIDDING ME WITH THIS???? I have never read something like this in ANY of the MC books I've read. Can I also add that at the point of this branding, SILVER HAS NOT EVEN TOLD PRESLEY HE LOVES HER. She was just like "sure, brand me with fire for a guy that may or may not love me".

The whole Savanna storyline was also ridiculous. Why Silver even liked her was beyond me. She was a terrible mother (but he was a terrible father, so there's that). The whole storyline made no sense. This book was also unnecessarily violent and crude. Based on the summary, I expected a completely different story than what I read.

This book was insulting to women and not worth reading.

Silver Hernandez, the hero in "UnScrew Me" will make you love to hate him because he's so set in his ways as the growly Treasurer of the Savage Beast MC. He's been in love with a member of Savage Beast MC's old lady since day one and when that member, Hawk becomes nomad and leaves his MC, abandoning his woman and 4 year old daughter, Trista, the chapter continues to support and protects them. Distraught Savanna, Hawk's ole lady is hurt and very bitter but still Silver wants her. She acknowledges to Silver that he can have her body but her heart belongs to only Hawk. Silver doesn't want that type of relationship so as

time passes, he has a son by a drugged- out groupie of sorts and she give him his child which he names Buster.

When Silver Hernandez meets heroine, 32 years old, Presley Gray (Buster's 3rd grade teacher) she has recently moved into a new town taking a teaching position and seeking ADVENTURE and YES does Presley gets said ADVENTURE with Silver! Buster is an endearing cute kid who had so many of his father's charming mannerism that it was too funny to read the words at times! The members and prospects of the Savage Beasts MC are all alpha men: tough, manly, frank and possessive take charge dudes and it makes for a gripping new series! Well. Shit. I love motorcycle club romance, but I will be the first to admit a lot of books involve violence against women-- all in the name of "dark and gritty" plots that are meant to shock and titillate. I do my best to avoid the most egregious examples of the subgenre. I read other Hayley Faiman books before and thought I was safe. She took it too far in Unscrew Me.

Silver, the so-called hero, is a rapist. There is just no other way to say it. With a gun held to her father's head, he "asks" a woman to go down on him. She complies. He rationalizes the act by saying it's about a show of power and control on behalf of his MC, not sexual desire-- which excuses nothing. It's a forced sexual encounter under threat of violence. It's rape.

Later, the heroine Presley is raped in the same way for the same reasons by another character. Why bookend the story that way? There are no parallels drawn between the first woman and Presley. And if that's not enough, Silver goes on to blame Presley for what happened to her and she agrees with him. It's her fault because she ran away and got kidnapped, the book says. What. The. Fuck.

There's a lot more to dislike about the book. Silver refuses to be monogamous to Presley, just in case club business requires him to stick his dick in a woman at some point, some time. It's literally the only thing she asks of him, and his best answer is "I'll try." He is an extreme jerk, even for an MC romance style alpha hero. Everything must be done his way and Presley must accept it if she wants any kind of relationship with him. There is no redemption through love. There is no journey to a mutually satisfactory ending. There is only capitulation.

I was really disappointed in Faiman for this book. It's one thing to write something raw and gritty, to show the darker side of life. It's quite another to exploit the sexual victimization of your female characters.
