Something about Cain McClutchen rubs Sammy the wrong way but on a terrifying case Sammy finds herself turning to the one person she doesn't trust in this spine chilling paranormal romance.

They've been given orders to get along or else and the reader can't help but get caught up in all the sparks that fly as tensions give way to something bright and surprisingly intimate as darkness surrounds them and a sinister presence makes things personal. The chemistry sizzles from every page with explosive heat even as the emotional angst that flows from the pages due to traumatic past experiences grips readers by the heart. Strong captivating characters grab the reader's attentions and their motivations are easily understood, while the fast paced, smooth flowing plot thrills readers with lots of suspense, chills and romance.

Expectations build spine tingling suspense throughout the story as the crew discover that the ghosts they are investigating has targeted Sammy and the excitement builds as the danger escalates with none of the crew being prepared for the evil they are facing. Well written scenes and details paint vivid images and make it easy for the reader to feel as if they are taking part in the investigation (be prepared for the hair raising and cold chills) and the intriguing events make it impossible for the reader to put the story down.

I was completely enthralled by this story from the very beginning, Kelly Moran has a gift for making the setting, characters and events work together to create a story that seems so very real. I have to confess that this is the first book that I have read by the author (it won't be the last) and while the story can be read as stand alone, I certainly missed out on getting to know the other members of the Phantoms crew and their stories.

I have been impatiently waiting for this book to come out for review ever since I accidentally stumbled upon the first two books in Ms. Moran's *Phantoms* series. It was definitely well worth the wait. I enjoyed the ARC - bad ARC formatting and all - so much I've already placed my preorder for the official release copy on Amazon. So, with the gushing bit out of the way, let's hit the details.

Ghost of You features Sammy and Cain, who sniped at each other from the moment they met in the previous book, and the tension on all levels clearly shows on the page. The development of the relationship between the characters and their ability to work through their trust issues to a mutual understanding of what they want from their relationship is entirely logical. It worked - better than I expected going in - and was greatly enjoyable. The ghost investigation plot is well balanced with the romance plot - both of them a well intertwined whole - and was extremely creepy and unnerving, especially when you consider that I have the sneaking suspicion that I know exactly what historic events Ms. Moran used as inspiration for her plot.

Overall this is an excellent finale to this series. I can't praise Ms. Moran or her *Phantoms* series enough.
