John Grisham is clearly a "brand" that is my favorite and I own all of his books that I've read. So my review is bound to be biased. I say brand (and not author) because to me John Grisham is a brand in crime fiction just as Xerox is a brand in photocopiers. The David Baldaccis of the world can't hold a candle to him. Maybe some of John Lescroart's works are close enough.
