But it is also the story of the last McNeill brother, Brock and an actress with a secret; one that she has to hold close to her in order to help her sister, Hope. Hannah Ryder is trying to get information on the notorious director and if he has ever done anything to any other woman like he did to her sister. But she has to be cautious because she doesn't know if the McNeill's are friends with him or not.

Her first meeting with the handsome cowboy happens when Brock tells the director that his horses have had enough and he was taking them.
