Tatum and Maggie did not catch my interest as much as Tripp & Scarlett did in the first book. Tatum is a nice and caring guy, but Maggie is disappointing. Yes, she had a bad previous relationship, but her handling

of the abusive ex coming back into her life is not realistic. She had ample opportunities to alert someone and get help to get rid of the abusive ex, but instead she just folds and puts up with his crap. Of course, then we would not have had much of a story. Tatum also misjudges the situation when he thinks the ex has just slithered away so politely. But then again, there would not have been much of a story if the ex had left so easily.
