This is a very short novel. It's about 53 pages long, and I loved every single page of it. If you are wanting a lot of emotional angst between the characters, this is not your book. It's a very sweet and sexy love story that is a quick satisfying read. I loved it!

John hasn't been out of college long. He was a very successful football player, but instead of pursuing a career in sports, his dream is to work in advertising. But, of course like everyone else, he must work his way up to the top. This means doing peon work at the advertising agency for a boss who really didn't notice him much anyway. To make matters worse, this is the first summer that he has had to work through. He is so used to having the summer off, being with friends and enjoying the sunshine at his leisure, that he is coming to realize that growing up and being responsible sucks.

When he walks into Annie's Diner on his lunch break, he notices two things. One it has no customers, (he doesn't get a lunch break until at least 3 everyday...isn't his boss a jerk?) and two the waiter is very handsome and is friendly. It's not long before the waiter, Keith, strikes up a flirtatious conversation with John. Both are immediately attracted to one another and genuinely interested in getting to know one another.

Keith is working his way through college. As a Sophomore and English major, he welcomes the summer break...even if he has to work through it. Keith is a fun, flirty, likeable, sexy man. When he meets John for the first time, they have an immediate connection between them. Each day John comes to the Diner to eat, so he can be around Keith and get to know the man he is coming to care for.

I loved the banter between John and Keith. Even though it was a short novel, I could literally see their relationship evolve into something worth taking a chance for. What I liked about them was they actually talked and got to know one another before they jumped into bed together. Not to say that the sexual chemistry between them wasn't intense because it was. I decided to buy this short story from Samhain and I'm very glad that I did. It's the summer and John is in his first job since leaving College. His car's in the garage so he walks into a nearby diner for lunch where he meets Keith who is spending the summer working at a waiter to pay his way through College. The writing is evocative enough to really bring the story to life. The heat of the summer comes across in the details from the sweltering wall of heat to the sticky lack of air conditioning. The cool ice cream combines with rich food to give a perfect taste of summer in this quick story. Although the time frame is about a week and focuses on the connection between the men, the bantering dialogue and solid descriptions keep this as a thoroughly enjoyable read.
