This is the fourth book in The Lost Breed Mc Series by Ali Parker and it is just as compelling as the first three. Angela is Axel's sister [he was the main 'hero' in book 2] and they come from the very wealthy Cooper family based in California- that is why Axel is living in New York far away from his parents as he did not want their lifestyle.
