After a slow, rocky start (the first 2-3 chapters), this second book in the Nightwalkers series really takes off and doesn't slow down for breath. There was too much exposition and re-capping in the beginning, no matter how relevant some of it was, and this lost it a star (it took me two tries to read this). But the chemistry and development of Gideon and Magdelegna was excellent, and you get to meet the Vampire Prince, Damien, and the Queen of the Lycanthropes, Siena. Bella and Jacob feature prominently, as Bella is viciously attacked and nearly killed by a new threat to the Demons, and they realise there's a traitor in their midst.

The plotline of Gideon and Legna is very interesting. What happens to Gideon is the ultimate female fantasy: that a man so reserved, arrogant, domineering and seemingly detached, can change, can be influenced in a positive way by a woman, who can - no, not *change*, but *bring out* certain repressed qualities. There are many women who have stayed in a relationship too long in hopes of "changing" their man, and fail because it's not changing the man at all, it's an attempt to release qualities of compassion, consideration, understanding, empathy etc, qualities that women in general value and require in others - if a relationship fails it's often because they weren't the right women to reveal this in the man, or perhaps he just doesn't have it in him. Whatever. Anyway, it's a fantasy that features predominantly in romance fiction, and in *Gideon* is quite beautiful and really makes you smile, because he's just so adorable in his vulnerability as well as sexy in his strength :) Yep: fantasy.

I've seen some complaints on other reviews that the first love scene doesn't appear until quite late in the book, but for me, this really built the anticipation and when it did finally happen it was lovely. The love scenes were certainly not the hottest I have read, but I felt that they were quite emotional, which suited the characters and the tone of the book.

I loved how Gideon gradually started to feel emotion after living without it for so long, and how Legna helps him to communicate with others and realise when someone is reaching out to connect with him.

I was compelled to give this 5 stars because of its success in gripping my attention back to this series alone after the awfully disappointing of the first one.

Now *this* is what I call a good romance! Here we have Gideon, the enigmatic Ancient healer of the demon race, and Legna, the kid sister of the King of the demon race and secret admirer of Gideon.

I already liked Gideon from the first book, perhaps even more so because of his hostility towards Isabella, the heroine of the first book who I absolutely *hated*. Gideon is the oldest surviving member of his race therefore he has great knowledge and is a well respected demon. It was already clear from the first book that he had a certain fascination towards Legna and this one only added to it. He's a cynical character, blunt and completely oblivious to any feelings of caring or loving another save for his patients. There's something extremely sexy about warming the stone-cold heart of a man who's been letting himself be haunted by mistakes of the past. And that is what Legna manages exactly.

Legna is a strong woman despite the overprotective efforts of her brother to shield her from the dangers of

their ways of life. She's always been both fascinated and intimidated at the same time by the Ancient healer and yet being the Mind demon herself she doesn't let that get in the way of their relationship after discovering they're Imprinted, destined to be each other's. I was so glad to see her not turn out to be like her predecessor.

There were some great hot moments in this book, especially the constant struggle Gideon had with his feelings were amazing in my opinion. Again with the cold guy falling in love being sexy ;) Gideon and Legna were adorable together, at times not afraid to challenge each other but the love and respect they held for one another was tangible. And the part where they find out about Legna's pregnancy must be one of the most sweet moments of paranormal romance books that put a smile on my face.

I was glad to see some new characters introduced to the story, like Damien the Vampire Ancient and Siena the Lycanthrope. I'm actually looking forward to reading their stories.

Gideon, the second book in the Nightwalkers series, was an okay read.
