First and foremost I'm not a big fan of romance novels with someone with amnesia. I struggle with them, and I'm not sure why. Don't get me wrong they can be awesome reads, but they tend to be emotionally rocky. In Michele de Winton's book, Love Lost and Found, is an amnesia story.

Felicity Williams doesn't remember the last five years. Instead of trying to figure out what happen in the last five years, she escapes and works on a cruise line. Figuring it would be a good time to take her life in a new direction.

Rick McCarthy finally comes out of his coma and finds that his fiancée has abandon ship and he has no clue where she could be. Basically, he goes looking for her and eventually finds her. She has no memories and no knowledge of being engaged to be married to her boss, Rick. He is in a coma and there is nothing to tell her their relationship is more than business.

Loved the scene on the deserted island. After going on survival mode, both characters embark in the fulfillment of primal desires. Great scenes follow with Rick trying to win Felicity over and make her fall in

love with him once again.

Love Lost and Found was an okay read. I love stranded together romances, but I'm iffy on amnesia. Several months ago, Rick and his business partner, Felicity, went rockclimbing. He proposed, she said yes, then they fell. Rick was in a coma, and when he came out of it learned that Felicity had been discharged weeks before and took off. He can't understand why she'd leave, but he's told that she has amnesia and the last five years are gone. Rick hires a private detective who finds her working on a cruise ship, and Rick knows that he needs to get her back even if she doesn't remember him.

Love Lost and Found started out weird for me. I get that Felicity was distraught and confused, but why would she run away across the world when she can't remember the last five years of her life? She's not going to figure it all out if she leaves her entire life behind! Meanwhile, Rick pretending like he doesn't know her was just a set up for unneeded drama. He does think she might be faking because of business reasons (and that's a whole other issue of its own), but he should have told her! Doesn't he think she wants to know what happened to her?! I doubt she'd get pissed to learn about her life, whereas she'd definitely be upset to find out that this charming "stranger" is a liar!

I was just not into Love Lost and Found. In a way, I liked how the amnesia angle played out in the end, but I really did not like how Rick treated Felicity at all. First he doesn't even believe her, and then he plays her for no reason. There's also an annoying amount of inner dialogue. I felt like most of the narrative was Rick and Felicity having random thoughts (so much italics!!!).

The amnesia trope in romance can go well or fall apart. That part of LOVE LOST AND FOUND was carried off well, I thought. Felicity and Rick were engaged until a rock climbing accident leaves him in a coma and her without the last five years' worth of memories. Since nothing in her current life is familiar, Felicity pretty much deserts Rick before he wakes up, and begins a new life on her own.

Rick needs to find her, which brings them back in contact, and getting stranded on an island together forces them to stay together.

To be honest, I felt bad for Felicity as Rick wouldn't let go of his negativity long enough to discover whether her amnesia was faked or not. He lied continually, even when given a chance for a new start. I didn't feel the chemistry between them enough to buy into their first sexual contact, so it wasn't sexy to me, but awkward.

On the good side, I loved Felicity and how she was going about her new life. If Rick had approached her romantically from the start, I would have been cheering him on. As it was, the banter carried me along enough to finish but my enjoyment wasn't as much as others might find.
