It's really sad that that many books get spoiled because of this kind of utter, unbelievable insta-everything, which is overdone to such a degree that I can't possibly find anything remotely believable in the whole setup of said romance.

I was about to give the book and its author brownie points for, at least, settling for overdone insta-attraction instead of the whole insta-love thing (which is even worse)... but I was wrong about that, too. Insta-love, hello my dear friend, how have you been??

I can't even decide what's most ridiculous here: that they're agreeing on some rules regarding their relationship according to which they have to leave all gang and cop business out of their love affair, thinking that *that* will actually work out, that they call it a relationship pretty much after their first shared kiss, that they *trust* each other immediately (hello? Gang leader? Cop?), or that the great Detective Gabe constantly tries to comfort Angelo regarding the hard and difficult gang-related decisions that he has to make, like making an example of one of his gang members whose loyalty wasn't a 100% with the gang by torturing and killing him. Gabe constantly tells Angelo that he's there for him and that he can talk to him about anything... which, what? Rules! Have they really already forgotten about them after like 10 seconds?

That being said, this book's setting/premise had potential. If done well, in a more realistic and believable way, I find myself enjoying the bad boy – cop liaison (even if this setting is actually rather unrealistic in RL, I'm well aware of that.. I'm merely asking for a more realistic *execution*).

The action part didn't hurt either. Long time since I read suspense and, yeah, it was time to go there again.

But this book was definitely the wrong choice. Or rubbish. That little word sums it up nicely.

I love when some external reason makes the relationship difficult. Gabe being a detective at NYPD, and Angelo being a criminal, precisely the head of Los Pescadores, one of Brooklyn's most notorious gangs, are definitely dealing with this kind of problem. **They are perfect together, their chemistry is sizzling hot, and uncontrollable.**

He stroked his tongue over Pagan's teeth and tongue, searching deep, needing more of that taste. That indescribable taste of Angelo Pagan he was quickly getting drunk on.

“Oh my God.” Gabe didn't recognize the words falling from his lips. They sounded wrecked, ravaged. Like his insides. Staring at Pagan's lips, red and glistening from his kisses, he couldn't catch his breath.

I recognize that many of my GR buddies enjoyed this book and I'm happy for them. I can say that the smexy scenes were pretty hot and the editing was good for Ellora's Cave. That said, I could not get past this sad excuse for a story line. At some point —quite long ago— was this a freebie at Amazon and a few days ago I added it with **the audio book** for just a few dollars.

..and a half

When I'd listening to the last page (a sweet epilogue)

I'd to think a few moments about what I actually felt for *Love the Sinner*. I knew that I should point out that this novel is incredibly erotic and that those parts (many) actually are really well done (at least in the narrated audiobook).

....But what about the story? There was a good, great actually, plot and story-line. My question was if it was here with us often enough and in an expected (by me at least) moderate part? I'm not sure...

Love the Sinner is an *Brooklyn, NY* pretty erotic M/M romance about the (until now straight) **Detective Gabriel (Gabe) Ashby** and his huge attraction and need for one of NYPD's Most Wanted. From their first meeting in the interrogation room is the smug **gang leader Angelo Pagan** in Gabe's dreams day and night.

Shortly after their first meeting becomes Gabe shot in the shoulder in an attempt to frame Angelo Pagan and some gang members. During Gabe's convalescence from the hospital stands there suddenly Angelo one evening in his doorway. An intense, steamy hot and partially forbidden story takes off...

“Tell me what you want.”

“To kiss you.” The words tumbled from his lips, harsher than he intended. “Just once. To know what it's like. What you taste like.”

Pagan's eyes darkened.

“Maybe then I'll be able to forget you.”

Pagan arched an eyebrow and stepped forward. "You think it's that simple?"
Gabe held his ground. "Yeah."

This book is really tough to rate for me...

The characters were interesting and I really liked these two men. The audio narration was always captivating intense but it was still, after all, far too many (long) —with short intervals for other stuff— amazing tiny kinky sex scenes, for my taste. I wanted more time and a lot more space for much else that was also very interesting here.

When it is a story with both insta-love, a GFY character, and to that also a closeted criminal gang leader and a recently single cop as MC's, then it becomes easy a lack of credibility. *Love the Sinner* could have been an fantastic romance if the substance and intrigue (the intriguing questions, the problems, the unlikely severe, etc) here had been given just a little more space and opportunity for development.

Anyway, I couldn't but enjoy to listening to *Cop & Angel's* lovely romantic love tale. I'll try to find time for book #2 as well some time not too far away (Sinner, Savior - about another interesting (closeted) gangster character who showed up here sometimes. A stand alone sequel with a higher average ranking).

"I can't change it and I don't want to. You're it for me." Angelo's body shook between Gabe's legs. "I gave you my heart in that fucking interrogation room, cop, yet you've been holding yours hostage from me."

If you have a thought of downloading (I shook up \$ 4) and listen to the audiobook edition (9 hours) then let the book get a little time before you start to roll your eyes too much. There is no denying that some of the characters is told by the narrator Renard Pasquale with pretty silly voices here. But don't worry to much you will (I did anyway) get used to it after a while.

I will not forget it in a hurry stuff and moments:

Imagine a horny sexy black haired intense lover, with a husky Brooklyn dialect (added with Spanish accent), whispering:

"Kiss me, cop. Then try to forget me."

Overall, was in the end, this narrators way to tell it all quite nicely done. I was, perhaps first reluctant, finally wholeheartedly captivated by it all. ...and it's a lot of yummy stuff for all you smut ladies.
