So after the whole Luna Werewolves series, which ended up getting on my nerves and annoyed me greatly with the same tropes, stock characters and so much sex (pages and pages of it) that felt rather empty and unnecessary, I was rather hesitant to read another series of hers. I decided to give this one a try. It's not bad. At least, it's not as bad as I was expecting. While it had the kidnapped mate trope, Anthony wasn't weak and needy like in the Luna wolves series and there's no mpreg, so that's a nice change.

I wonder if this is connected in any way to the Vampire District series, because it feels like it's in the same universe. It mentions a war, and paranormals taking over and each (werewolves, vamps, etc) ruling their own areas. She had a start of a Werewolf District series with only one book, but I wonder if that was abandoned in favor of this?

All in all, it feels more like her older series and not the (IMO) less appealing Luna Werewolves. Though, I'll have to see. This one seems to be a series with connected plots, not stand-alone, so time will tell if like in the Luna series, things just drag on and on with no reason or completion or not. I'm willing to continue reading to find out, though.

As always when I read one of these books I feel obligated to at least rate it a 3. Going in, I know this isn't going to be a 5 star book so it isn't fair (in my opinion) to hold it to a higher standard. It is what it is, a quickie shifter book, and for what it was I enjoyed it well enough. The main feature of the story is the sex, the two MCs discover they are mates, and the premise is a human mate bringing a 'royal' alpha to his knees, the theme which gets carried over to the next book as well (which I rather liked). Our couple falls in love within a two week span, and there's a challenge for position that gives our poor human a chance to prove he's not as bad as the wolves think. Nothing groundbreaking, but a nice easy read.

As a side note, it was both a nice change of pace and yet a bit limiting not to have to read definitions of what it means to take a mate. So often when reading shifter stories our sub is oblivious to his role as a mate and we the reader have to go over the 'rules' each time. It was refreshing not to have to revisit something that we as the experienced readers already know; however at the same time, some authors define mates differently, so a quick one sentence overview might have been nice. Overall I'm getting better acquainted with Marcy Jacks books, she's an easy go to for my guilty pleasure genre since I have read so many other authors already, its good to find one I haven't exhausted yet!
