This was a fun, hot and captivating read, which started off brilliantly with the way Zane is determined to show Bea that deciding whether she's the right person for the job he's offering doesn't need to be a major interview, and instead, that there's fun to be had. Although, it's palpable he's already decided, because she's an interesting woman that he's determined to get to know better. Will they give into their instant and intense

chemistry straight away?

As for the dialogue, there was playful banter and hot dirty talk that led to even hotter intimacy, which proved these two are great together, if Bea can let her guard down enough to let Zane in. However, the teasing banter was balanced exceptionally well by the intense moments due to the main characters back stories.
