Dark Moon Rising centers around a 29 year old woman, Alex, who acts more like a rebellious teenager. Frequently called to her father's office asking "am I in trouble?" Can't leave the house without bodyguards. She lives in a world of vampires but doesn't know it, when she finds out she takes off running hoping to save her twin brother that has been turned into one. Repeatedly told not to trust anyone, she goes about trusting every single person she meets.

It's a bit of a chaotic read. Alex is told she's been asleep for three months and her friend is suddenly asking if she's going clubbing with them tonight. Then Alex ponders the last few weeks - she was just told she'd been out of it for three months.

While the author states at the beginning that this is South African English the grammatical errors are frequent, "do you know where my brother are", "her body were identified." Almost every instance of "off" is written as "of." The dialogue can be difficult to follow as well, when two women are in the scene "she" says this and "she" says that but you're not sure which "she" is talking. While the story has potential what it really needs is an editor.
