The years don't feel like they line up, towards the end of the book she's planning her 18th birthday party yet the beginning talks about being 130. Maybe the whole book fixes this feeling. I think that maybe the beginning was current and then the rest is a recap of her life, judging by the bold print then regular print, but it was run together so it's hard to tell.
