Forlorned, bibliophile Eva, pining for entitled, playboy billionaire's love and attention from childhood, becomes part of Andrew 's father's, Blake's, will and a stipulation for him to become CEO of the company. Eva, now grown up, and a beautiful librarian, has to move forward and forgive Andrew for his past dismissive attitude towards her. While Andrew quickly realising that she is his soul mate, the person he was searching for during his wild 'playa' days must try to convince her that he has changed and truly loves her. Yes, they live HEA as she bore him a son, sealing his fate as the company's CEO.

With uni-dimensional characters, especially the shallow main character, Andrew, this novel falls flat despite the HEA ending as Blake predicted and mandated by his will. There are too many descriptions of what the people are wearing that were irrelevant to the story, or repeated phrases describing her 'luscious curves' and skin color, that only portrayed Andrew as a horny teenager and not a mature man in love with his soul mate. Eva's lack of a backbone throughout was unbelievable as Andrew's ability to run a billion dollar company, without putting in any time at his father's side to 'learn the ropes'. Now let's not forget the elephant in the room, 'having unprotected intercourse'! Andrew, not having a second thought about donning a condom, made me realized that it was normal for him in this age of AIDS and other STIs(Sexually Transmitted Infections). He, as far as we know and can assume since the author was bent on telling the reader every inconsequential detail, did not have an STI exam done on himself before engaging with sexual relations with Eva.
