Duplicity by Vicki Hinze This is an amazing military romantic suspense thriller at its best. Lots of action with twists and turns it keeps your attention to the very end. Air force attorney Captain Tracy Keener is assigned the toughest case of her legal career as a JAG officer. She must defend Captain Adam Burke, an Intel operative who is accused of killing and abandoning his men while on a covert mission, accused of treason, cowardice and murder. She realizes defending him could ruin her military career.

Everyone, including Tracy, believes that Captain Burke is guilty, but things don't always appear as they seem. Adam tells Tracy that he has been set up and so has she, even though she does not believe what he tells her she begins to search for answers.

When Tracy uncovers some proof to what Adam is telling her is true; he mysteriously dies in a fire. Feeling guilty for Adam's death she continues to push for the truth although she is ordered by her superiors to close the case, Tracy risks her life to find answers. With Adams return and with the help of Tracy they uncover a government conspiracy called "Project Duplicity," which a chemical compound called retorsarin, which is behind the deaths of several officers. Treason, murder, betrayal and greed are behind in the conspiracy to keep Duplicity secret until it passes the trials and a government funding is granted. Forced together under extreme circumstances a bond forms between them because they must rely on each other to stay alive to bring the truth out in the open. This book was great!
