If you have yet to read Teaching Willow: Session 1 yet then you missed out on a cluster fuck waiting to happen involving a girl, Her teacher and her twin sister. TW1 introduced us to Willow Masters, naive and repressed college student totally infatuated with her professor Ebon Daniels. We discovered her twin sister Sage was dating Ebon for a time and also learned the desperate lengths Willow will go to in order to have the one thing she desires above all else. The one thing she fears she cannot have.

She's spun herself a nice little cozy web built on lies and deception and is reaping the fruits of said treachery. I think Bono said it best in the U2 song "Pride" when the chorus chimes in with "What more in the name of love?" Willow is a very interesting character. Meeting her in the last book my impression of her was that of a shy and somewhat innocent young woman. She's starting to blossom into a full blown vixen the more time she spends with Ebon and I equally love and hate it. love it because she's opening up and discovering new things about herself and hate it because she's completely comfortable on the cliff she's dangling precariously from. We get a deeper sense of who she is in this story and she's got some Koo-Koo bird tendencies just waiting to bust out. Hints about a past event with an older man promise to bring juicy enlightenment in the next installments.

My feelings for Ebon Daniels are just as confusing to me as mine for Willow. Some moments I want to console him for the deceit he has no idea he's involved in and then others I want to gouge his eyes out with a goddamn grapefruit spoon. His conflicted emotions about the two sisters while hot in the bedroom does nothing for my emotional stability as a female. He's hot and cold like the song and I feel bipolar in my up and downs with him. Ebon has a little bit of a hidden past that seems to be stalking him lately also. Well, session two is certainly heating things up between Sage (Willow) and Ebon. It's definitely becoming much more layered and convoluted and the lies have sprung new lies, which have, in turn, grown their own lies.

So when we left off in session one, Willow had finally gotten Ebon ... but as Sage. And so she was going to continue this relationship with Ebon under the guise of Sage, for as long as she could. She knew it would eventually have an end date, but for the time she could have him, she would take him.

It's so crazy to me that she's so okay with living this lie, knowing it can't continue forever. But you do get the sense of foreboding more in this session. She's already planning for the demise of the lies she's spun, and she's being a touch more reckless with allowing Willow to come through during her time as Sage.

There's definitely more to both of their histories, and I'm looking forward to that being uncovered. We slowly got more in this session, as Willow visited a doctor and the discontinuation of "meds" was once again brought up. I'm intrigued where all that's concerned, but I don't want to give away any of my theories just yet. As for Ebon ... if that's even his name ... he's got some sort of shady past, too, apparently, and I'm guessing that'll be coming to a head soon.

Willow and Ebon's relationship, as student and teacher, sort of mellows out in the first portion of this novella, but by the end, it seems there's more desire there. I will say, it is very weird to me that a teacher, who wants to keep his distance from his student, would encourage said student to continue writing about his sex life with her sister. Seems kinda creepy to me. Definitely not a choice topic I would write about.

The side of Willow, as Sage, with Ebon has significantly heated up. They're using the writing to further their sexual escapades, and overall, they're very well written; however, I'm not a fan of the "c-word" during sex scenes. At all. To me, it's a derogatory term, so when I crossed that twice in this story, it was a turn off for me.

Okay, so Willow is fully immersed in her life as Sage now, living the lie and drowning in it on a daily basis. I was stressed FOR her as she tried to juggle living as Sage to be with Ebon and still having to maintain her normal 'Willow life' both with him and for her own basic routine. Willow was stressed and stretched to the

max as she tried to hold onto this bliss that she has with the man she's falling so hard for, but it's like she's trying to hold onto a broken glass that keeps losing it's pieces. She's losing her heart to Ebon, and she's desperately trying to keep the lie going just because the idea of not having him, whether it's as Sage or herself, is unbearable. As easy as it would be to judge her and say what she's doing is completely wrong, at the same time, it's clear that Ebon is falling for Willow, not Sage. Even as she pretends to be her sister, Willow comes to the surface whenever they are together, and that's what Ebon is starting to open up his heart to.

Ebon opens up to Willow's Sage on deeper levels this time around, and the moments they shared went from entirely sweet and tender to smoking hot steamy...and I loved it!!
