DIDN'T LIKE: frequent spelling, word errors; lack of descriptive detail (except in sex scenes) in order to keep the story short ; too much info about the separate parts could have been more time spent on the story instead ; story fails to get my empathy for the characters bcz it is too brief;

HATED: Separating already short stories into so many parts, and then separating again for differing protagonists, just gets more confusing; bcz of all the "free sampling" of chapters in each book (part) & added info explaining the separated parts, included in every book, adds up to more confusion than necessary for prospective buyers.
