Aunt Rosie's flower shop and is struggling to meet expenses, since a competitor has taken over all of the funeral business in her small town. She has also sworn off men, since her husband abused her. On the other hand as strange events occur around her business she makes the acquaintance of Alex, a policeman handsome policeman with "chocolate drop eyes." She tries to avoid his appeal, but is unable to do so.

In the second book, she is again involved in a strange series of events that involves the death of a good friend of her delivery driver and her fiancée. She and Alex have many suspects, but are not close to solving the murder. The main suspect disappears and is believed to have been taking bribes. He does return and this ends with the arrest of the last person to be suspected.

The third and shortest book takes place around Christmas and the problems Quincy has in arranging the annual Christmas tour. Alex, is not a policeman in their local town, but is investigating criminal charges of another member of the local police. Also, Quincy meets Alex's parents and that causes more issues with their off-again, on-again romance.
