This book! Ugh! It started off intriguingly enough, with a modern GI Jane character somehow getting thrust back in time during a car crash. It ends at about 40%, forcing you to buy the next installment if you care enough to do so, and gives you a reach-around BDSM book that I didn't bother to read.

So right away, after meeting the 1775 man, both engage in killing a few men. How romantic!

Like in the last book I read by this author, h is engaged to a drip. The H is newly betrothed. h becomes a servant in H's household, with no details as to life in those times and just magically becoming a domestic after serving a few tours in Iraq.

H is somehow supposed to come off as brooding and noble, but to me he just seemed spineless. h, named Honor, is from a military family and starts out as fierce, but ends up somewhere long the lines of June Cleaver. Having not paid attention in history class, Honor remembers reading a book of her brother's about

the revolutionary war, and suddenly is all colonial and knowledgeable about the Battle of Bunker Hill. She uses her flag tattoo to prove to the H that she is from the future.

The dialogue, including the H saying "okay" at least twice, is not fitting, and the one servant comes across as sounding like someone from Gone With the Wind. It is told in the first person. It is just a silly, non-romantic book. It could have been a lot better with some research and character development.
