I must preface this review by stating that the Scanguards Vampire series is one of my favorite series ever. With that said, Quinn's Undying Rose did not, overall, disappoint me.

Having read about Quinn in prior books in the series I loved having the opportunity to learn what made him the brooding, workaholic vampire that he is. The story of his love for Rose before he was turned was, at once, touching and heartbreaking.
