Journey really stole the show in this one for me. I was a little nervous for her book as she seemed a bit alpha to me in Black Sheep. While she is totally kickass, she has a very sweet, vulnerable side. All Journey has wanted since she was a teen is to be a mom and have a family. She is so loyal, kind, and loving. Her family is everything to her and when she's with them it's the only time she feels like she can totally be herself. Donovan is what I found different in this story from her others. Donovan wears a mask everyday, never showing anyone who he truly is. From the moment he saw Journey he knew that she was what he wanted. In that respect he is the same as Bijou's other Hs. Donovan lives the life everyday that is expected of him. He became a cop because that is what Mooney men do. He never allows anyone to get close to him because he can't let his mask fall. He only has brief interactions with women that never lead to anything more. He knows he wants Journey but also doesn't know how he's going to let down the walls for her to step through. So, in a way it seems like he's stringing her along and that he will never change. The only other person he has a somewhat close relationship with is his cousin Court. Even this he keeps hidden from the rest of the world because Court is in the Rawkfist MC and the Mooney side of his family will not accept this relationship because cops aren't supposed to mix with the local MC. There really are so many layers to Donovan that are slowly peeled away throughout this story.

Journey and Donovan have a lot to fight through to get their HEA. But Journey's a fighter so she is up to the challenge. It takes Donovan a bit but when he finally decides he absolutely can not let Journey go, he fights harder than anyone for what he wants.
