This is our review of the Third book of Regan Black's Shadows of Justice Series. We were very excited to be asked to review this book and found we wished to read Book One and Book Two in the series first. Although these books can be stand alone, you certainly will want to read all three. They are that good!!!!

Veil of Justice features Kelly and Nathan. Kelly was Petra's secretary, in Book 2 who had gone missing. Nathan is Petra's brother, also a telepath. He has gone under cover to prove the evil Dr Leo Kristoff is tampering with DNA and other genetic alterations that are impairing soldiers in the field. Kristoff has not only killed many Nathan had served with, but is now after something that has become very important to Nathan, Kelly.

Nathan's cover has him arrested for murder. While incarcerated he begins a telepathic connection to Kelly. She becomes his lifeline. When he starts to fracture and can no longer physically nor emotionally stay in solitary, he cries out to her for help. Kelly comes to his aid. Again the battle is for good over evil. Jaden and Brian, along with Petra and Gideon are brought in to solve the puzzle.

Kelly hides her history from everyone, almost until it is too late. She has always felt like the family failure, being the only daughter of six brothers and an Alpha father. We learn that her family's mission has been to protect something. Her father and brothers are slaughtered and Kelly again thinks she was never part of them.

I will not spoil the plot any further. What I will do is discuss how much I enjoyed reading all three of these well written, well thought out stories, that entwined themselves for this trilogy. I think I liked the fact that each story had a woman as a warrior. Each heroine had strengths in her own right, and was certainly not a damsel in distress. Veil of Justice is the third book in the Shadows of Justice series, this one focuses on Nathan (Petra's brother) and Kelly (Petra's assistant) from Book 2, Invasion of Justice.

The year is 2096 and Nathan has been imprisoned for a crime he didn't commit. All is not what it seems though, as Nathan is actually undercover. Kelly has had a mental connection with Nathan for some time and they have been conversing (and other things) in their heads. In "Invasion of Justice" Kelly had stolen Nathan's vintage mustang and disappeared. Six months later and there is still no word of her whereabouts, despite Petra and Jaden's efforts to find her. During the course of the book we find out Kelly has secrets of her own and has been living a double life all along. She ran away because she must return to her family home and solve the mystery of the murder of the male members of her family and find a long lost family relic or our world as we know it will be seriously affected. Meanwhile, Nathan contacts Kelly through their mental connection and asks her to help him escape prison. So the fast paced, action packed ride begins.

Petra and Gideon from "Invasion of Justice" along with Jaden and Brian from "Justice Incarnate" return in this book as well as the supporting cast of characters from the both books. The evil Dr. Kristoff with his surrogate son Simon, play a large part in the plot and are still just as nasty as before. Nathan and Kelly each have unique abilities and issues which play a large part in the plot of the story. Like the first two books, this one is action packed with lots of hardcore rockum, sockum fight scenes. There is a romance trying to bloom between Nathan and Kelly but Kelly's past seems to keep getting in the way. Written in the same style as the first two, we have bits of snarky comments and fun dialogue interspersed between the action scenes.

This is an adult urban fantasy book with some adult language and adult love scenes but above all it's just a plain ole good action read. I enjoyed this book just as much as the first two and am now left wondering if the series will be continued and hoping it will be. I highly recommend this book to anyone who enjoys urban fantasy with some romance and mystic legends thrown in.

It seemed like a reasonable start and end to what should have been a five minute relationship in Mira's Gift, a short by Regan Black. Except readers clamored for more. I should know. I was one of them.

Shadows to Light continues the incredible journey through 2096 Chicago, where caffeine is illegal, the bad guys can get inside your head, and a woman who can heal with her touch is on the run and trying to save her father.

Along the way, she picks up Jameson, the man she kissed in a moment of weakness after she saved his brother's life. A kiss neither of them have forgotten. He's charged with protecting her. As much as any of Regan Black's kick-butt heroines need protecting.

Black's built another great romance into a fantastic urban fantasy adventure that includes shopping at Water Tower Place. And how many people can do that convincingly? *Shadows of Light* is strong as a stand-alone read, but better if you know the cast and crew from the whole series. (Plus, then you remember that we've met Mira in all the books!)

She saved his brother's life. Now it's time for Jameson to return the favor. And maybe, just maybe, find happiness and help the world in the process.
