Cult of Beauty is the story of Katie, a 22 year old supermodel who goes home to attend her mother's funeral. She is alone and without any close family. Katie is taken in by her step-father, Daniel. This is a fictionalized memoir, but the reading felt more like reality and I wondered where the lines were blurred. How much of this story was close to the raw reality of this life and lifestyle? If you like "light erotic", this is not for the faint of heart.

I was intrigued and pulled into this book, but I also kept feeling like I needed to turn away. Katie is on a sexual discovery involving everything from women, collage aged and older men. The secret life of a supermodel is very appropriate for the subtitle to this book. This story tells of the secret world of sex, money, fame. But also I felt that this story told of sexual cultures, norms and perceptions. It pointed out the differences between a more European view on sexuality versus a more conservative view other parts of the world may take. But, I felt that despite the view there was always an underlying curiosity.

It was interesting to find out the author, K M Dylan, was a model herself. The story is wrote "loosely" on her own experiences as a supermodel. Just a few pages in I was Googling the author to find out more. I wasn't for sure if this was a work of fiction, or more of a memoir.
