This book can be read as a stand alone, but to get a more complete picture of brothers Xander and Lex' s history, you should also read London Bound.

Xander and Imani meet due to Imani doing research for a part in a play, and needing money to pay a debt. There was instant attraction. Not the "OMG, I am instantly in love" attraction, but a strong physical attraction, along with being intrigued by each other's personality.

They spend a week in Paris with Imani pretending to be Xander' s significant other. Both have past hurts they are confronting in different ways. The relationship blossoms and neither are quite sure how to handle it. Xander is determined to go through with the plot for revenge he had planned. It's his driving force, but will it bring the satisfaction he believes it will? Imani is struggling with holding on to her independence, keeping her secret, dealing with an ex, and taking care of her family.

Xandere and Imani have a strong passion. Nana Malone writes this story so that you are not just reading it, you are feeling it.
