ONE SOUTHERN NIGHT is a novella, so it's a very quick read that only took me about an hour to finish. But despite it being a quick read, I thought the story moved at a good pace. The story does span a few months, but at no point did I feel like I'd miss something important just by blinking. I liked the quirky banter the characters had both out loud and in their heads. While the story takes place at high school, Laney and Kam didn't behave like I expect kids that age to act. There was a little drama when Laney's trust in Kam was tested, but other than that they came across as very mature. The story is told in Kam's POV, with Laney only
