We get a lot of reminders of stuff that has been mentioned in nearly every single Nancy Drew book since 1930 but nothing new that lasts beyond the current book. The publisher gets points, however, for the setting.

First of all, this is a bit stupid, but I didn't know that the two books aren't the original Nancy Drew series.
