I was disappointed by the last novel and hesitant to continue, but I'm glad I did. This penultimate installment to the God Wars series definitely moved the overall series plot forward and has a surprising twist in the end. I'm definitely not hesitant to read the next and last in this series!

After sacrificing herself in the last novel, Blood Revolution (God Wars #3), to save her father, Breanne is brought back to life by the Larentii Wise Ones. It takes her a while to decide to return to the land of the living though, and once she does, she's able to help Kay and pick up at least 3 new mates. She still faces numerous issues with Sirenni obsessions, including someone close to her, and she has to work with Ashe and the rest of her Earthly crew to root out the rogue gods and their cohorts there. a major cliffhanger at the

end sets up the last novel well.

As far as relationships go, I feel like there is a little growth/depth added in this novel in regards to previously established relationships, but as with the old mate relationships, so it goes with the new ones - there isn't much development before people decide they're mates. the mystical M'fiyah (soulmate recognition) is ever present, and so people decide they want to be mates with someone else without there being any substance to the relationship. that can be a bit difficult to accept, even if you're able to accept the concept of multiple mates. honestly, Breanne's mates don't really present an appealing advertisement for multiple mates (in fact, none of these series do).

Still, the rest of the plotline is intriguing and some new information is revealed about The One and The Three which will prompt a reader to pick up the next novel.
