Speaking to Dawn about this book before reading it, she confessed she was very worried. Coming off the back of a series that people love, she worried this book would live up to people's expectations. I could see her concern. In fact, me telling her that Mae is one of my top 5 all time favourite books didn't exactly soothe her nerves. Still if there is one thing I've learnt about Dawn and her books, they rarely disappoint. Connie & Isaac is another cracker.

This is book 3 of the Blue Butterfly series and although they don't follow on (this actually goes back in time), I would still recommend reading them in order. Plus everyone has to read Mae as far as I'm concerned.

I'm going to take for granted if you've got this far that you've read the first two books and you know what you are expecting.

Our book opens when Isaac is 19, Connie is 13 and Isaac has been sent to kill Connie and Mae. From here we find out what happened to make Connie leave with him, her initiation into becoming and her life as a Phantom, until her taking Mae's daughter into her care. And what a journey it is.

It's a real skill to be able to weave a dark story and still add beauty to it. It's especially hard in this tale, as there are very little shades of light. However, a great big burning patch is Isaac's love for Connie. Whilst not a conventional relationship, you see how deeply entwined they are. And then of course, there is Connie's love for Mae, the overriding factor as to why she starts her new life.

But more than that, she was the regular beat in my heart, and I knew, the moment I closed the door behind me, that it would never beat properly again."
