In this latest installment of the Saints Protection & Investigation series, we finally get Marc's book! Marc is a pilot and an outdoors man, so it's only natural that part of his story takes place in his plane and in the Canadian wilderness. His heroine was a bit of a surprise, because Kendall is a lab researcher and anything but an outdoors person. However, thrown into a desperate situation together with Marc, she realizes that she is much more of a survivalist than she would have thought.

Marc and Kendall are instantly attracted to each other and, although a bit overwhelmed of how quickly things develop, they act upon their feelings and plan a common future. Like in many of Maryann's books, they don't need a lot of drama to find out what they want. Instead we get lots of drama in the suspense story line, with Marc and Kendall crashing with their plane in a snow storm in the wilderness, being rescued, and then chasing the person behind this attack.

This is another great book in a great series. It can be read as a stand-alone but I would recommend to read the books in order for maximum enjoyment.

Unfortunately all the Saints have found their woman now... but it seems there is at least one more book to come. I'm definitely looking forward to it!

However, on the day he was set to fly out, the FBI threw a curveball at him, telling him he was moving the doctor's daughter instead.

While angry and frustrated, he still agrees to do it. He's eager to move the beautiful woman that's so far from his type, but sabotage happens. Over Canada he realizes his fuel gauge was tampered with and they're running on empty. He tells Kendall to prepare herself because they're going to crash.

I have been waiting in anticipation for Marc's story and the author did not disappoint! Marc Jenkins receives a new assignment to fly Dr Rhodes, a renowned microbiologist, back to the US from Alaska.
