Another reason is that Ren would do anything for Kelsey. ANYTHING to keep her safe as opposed to Kishan who does anything Kelsey says. If Lokesh's men were to ambush (which they did but that's not the point) the three right now, Ren would fight for her even though Kelsey would beg him not to. Kishan would listen.
