An abrupt shift in direction makes this less than satisfying. It's going to be hard to see how the series can retain a light feel to it after this volume.

Luna keeps fighting with Knightfall, but the stress is starting to build. Not just for her, too, Jennifer is buckling over it too. It will lead to some shocking decisions. Luna will have to choose between her agency and her life.

I'm not sure that I'm okay with it, because it's going to make any future volumes a lot more serious. By killing a specific character it makes that point explicitly, and it's come full circle from a fluffy story about relationships and ninjas to a serious tale about spying and betrayal. Going to be interesting to see where future volumes go.
