An Everlasting Bite is my first and definitely not last book of author Stacey Kennedy. Where have I been, that I hadn't read one of her books? Shame on me! Anyways, I loved this new series that is actually a spinoff to one of her others that I need to get reading.

Rynn is a young woman who was attacked and violated by a werewolf and now has become one herself. Luckily a mate has been chosen for her and is by her side every second as she recovers from the trauma. Briggs is the Beta to the head honcho of all the werewolves; he's sweet, protective and will do anything for his Rynn.

With only weeks to recover she goes with Briggs to a pack meeting, where she ends up help another Alpha find his missing daughter. But as they seem to get closer to finding her more wolves start dying and now the packs are wondering who the real target is.

I loved the packs, characters, romance and just well, everything! Rynn is such a great lead, having to put aside her trauma to help find this girl. Plus she has to deal with being the only human turned wolf in a really long time, making other wolves in the pack unsure about her.

The romance between Briggs and Rynn is just amazing and so passionate it made me squee like a teen. I loved their relationship and how Briggs handles her struggles and past with such kindness, even though he's a tough and extremely protective guy.

And, yes its my opinion that you have to read the other series to get the full effect of this series. I, however, did not know that. So when I started reading this series it felt like I missed something...like maybe the first book. It wasn't really confusing as they do give you a recap, but when you read this book Briggs and Rynn are already together. It would have been nice to read about them getting together and all that Rynn went through in her initial change. And, I don't honestly know that it's even explained in other series, and if it is it's probably not from their perspective so it the effect may be lost. Also, when I started reading this I looked it up on Goodreads and saw that there was a link for the reading order, but when I clicked on it the link did not work. Not to mention the book and the other series (which was suppose to be re-released April of this year) were also not listed on her website. So I was very confused. That all set aside it was still a good read. I loved Briggs and I liked Rynn. Considering everything she's been through she acts pretty tough. The novel actually reminded me a lot of the Alpha & Omega series by Patricia Briggs, which I loved. There were some things about the novel that bothered me, but overall this was a pretty decent read.

Bad:

Sometimes the books really focused on their love and worry for one another. It talks about the little touches they give each other, the re-assuring hand squeezes and smiles, and all the emotions that they feel through their bond. I wouldn't mind the occasional mention but it was mentioned quite a bit throughout the novel to the point where I thought it was taking up writing space that could have been used for more story line.

Another thing was that the beginning of their love story was missing. In my opinion it should be released in a novella or separately and be in their P.O.V so that I don't have to read two or three books of another series just to get the beginning of this one. Then there was the fact that it was a short book. I thought more thought and plot could have gone into the novel to make it a more enjoyable and capturing novel
